- •There will be no callback auditions for this show; therefore, we will be treating this audition like a callback. **IN OTHER WORDS**: Come relaxed and be prepared to "get into it" (i.e. be silly, and be ready to "leave it all on the stage!")
- •This is not a show that requires many Stage Crew members; however, If you are interested in Stage Crew/Tech only, <u>you do not need to come to auditions</u>. Please see Mrs. Abell to be added to the Stage Crew/Tech list.

NOTE – The SHOW DATES are April 19-20, 2024. Rehearsal schedule will be Tuesdays/Thursdays after school starting in January. Cast Participation Fee for HFS Drama Club will be \$100 per Student (\$50 for 2nd Student/Sibling). The Stage Crew Participation fee is \$30 (for meals/T-shirt). We will collect these fees when we begin rehearsals for the show.
