Uniforms

Over the past week or so, there has been confusion as to the transition from the old Squad Locker gym uniforms to the new Flynn O'Hara uniforms. In a nutshell, students were supposed to be wearing the black Squad Locker uniform with the school logo on it. Students should be transitioning to the Flynn O'Hara uniform with the new logo on it. This includes a gray t-shirt (long or short

sleeves), a maroon sweatshirt (if desired) with the new logo, maroon sweatpants (required) with the new logo, and maroon gym shorts (required) with the new logo.

The Squad Locker items and the Flynn O'Hara items are the ONLY acceptable uniform pieces for gym. Uniform infractions will be issued for any student not in the correct uniform.

Additionally, I have noticed in all grades that students are not wearing the appropriate sneakers with the regular, daily uniform. Students may wear plain black or plain white sneakers. If the shoe is black/white and the logo is white/black, that's fine; however, I'm seeing students wearing sneakers with flowers on them, colored logos, etc. Please check to see what items need to be corrected/updated.
