Thank you to everyone who was able to attend our Town Hall earlier this week. Father Arechabala, the Board of Limited Jurisdiction, and I all appreciate your comments, suggestions, and concerns.

One of the biggest concerns that came up focused on student enrollment and what we are doing not only to maintain enrollment but also to increase enrollment. Some things that we are doing include lining up shadow days with Phoenixville's days off, reaching out to St. Ann's Prep students, offering transfer grants to students who come from public/charter schools and are enrolling in 2nd through 7th grades, and utilizing our social media; however, we can do more.

To that end, in the coming weeks, I will be organizing a small marketing committee to discuss new ways in which we can share information about Holy Family with families who are outside of our immediate community.

It has also been brought to our attention that our families would like more communication with the Board of Limited Jurisdiction. In order to bring together the Board and our families, and perhaps Home and School, we discussed the idea of holding a General Parent Meeting a few times a year. That is another idea that we will work on putting together in the coming weeks.

Again, it's important to me that you know just how much I appreciate your taking the time to meet with us on Monday. We all want the same thing - to see Holy Family School grow and thrive. I will continue to do everything I can to achieve that goal, and I look forward to working with you.

#### **Arrival and Dismissal Procedures**

With our first day of school quickly approaching, all families should be aware of our arrival and dismissal procedures.

#### K-8 Students

- The cafeteria doors open at 7:45AM. Students will not be allowed into the building until that time. Please do not drop off your child without seeing him/her enter the building.
- Ctudanta will anter the building through the defetoric dear on Duttenwood Ctreet

- Doors close at 8:10. After 8:10, a parent must ring the bell at the main doors and sign in his/her child in the office.
- Any Kindergarten student who is half day will eat lunch with his/her class at 10:55, and they will be dismissed to the office. Parents should pick up their child in the office.
- Dismissal begins at 3:00PM.
- Students who are car riders will be escorted out to the fenced in blacktop parking lot next to the original building. Parents are asked to wait INSIDE the fenced area as it makes it easier for the teachers on duty to keep track of the students as they leave with a parent.
- Parents may park in the Griffin Hall lot and on the street during drop off and pick up. There is no parking permitted on the school side of the street.

#### PreSchool/PreK Students

- PreSchool and PreK student drop off for students in Mrs. Nieves's class, and Mrs. Orr's
  classes is from 8:00-8:20 at the breezeway doors located between the main building and the
  original building. A teacher/aide will be at the door to greet you and your child.
- Drop off for Mrs. Cucinotta's and Mrs. Mitchell's classes are at the Griffin Hall doors during the same time frame.
- PreSchool and PreK parents may walk their children into the building for the first week, only if necessary.
- Dismissal from the AM session is at 11:15AM. Parents will pick up their child(ren) at the same door as drop off.
- Parents may park on the street.

### Morning Car Line - K-8

- If you are driving your child(ren) to school, please see the attached graphic for proper car line drop off.
- If you are on Third Avenue approaching from Main Street, make a right onto Buttonwood Street and pull up to just past the telephone pole.
- Please DO NOT turn left from Third Avenue onto Buttonwood Street to drop off your child(ren).
   This potentially creates traffic issues with the school buses, other drivers, and our students crossing the street.
- Your child(ren) should be read to exit the car on the school side of the vehicle.
- Parents remain in the car. If you must get out, please park and walk your child(ren) to the door.
- Teachers will be outside to assist your child(ren)
- If you are on Third Avenue approaching from Gay Street, your child should exit on the right side of the vehicle, and go to the corner to be crossed by the crossing guard.
